Holocaust Articles Assignment Questions

The Holocaust was a genocide that claimed six million lives and left an indelible stain on the twentieth century. This dark time in our history demonstrated that a lack of resources, combined with propaganda and fear tactics, can drive a nation into dehumanizing an entire people and partaking in organized, systematic murder. These articles focus on the Holocaust, and you will learn about Nazi efforts to exterminate Jews and other groups, and the lasting effects of the Holocaust on political issues in the Middle East.
