

Letters to Vietnam Activity

In your notebook, you are to write a **full** page letter responding to the letter of your choice.

You are going to pretend that you are the loved one that the soldier is writing to and are responding back to the letter. Put yourself in their place and pretend you are writing in the time of the Vietnam War.

In your letter you must include:

1. Address the events that the soldier talked about (IE – Re-state what happened, ask specific questions about the event, ask soldiers to elaborate on the event etc.)
2. Tell the soldier what is happening in your daily life – remember you are taking the place of the soldier's loved one.
3. Tell the soldier what your plans to do together when they get home.
4. Ask the soldier 2 questions about factual information that you've heard about Vietnam (IE – Weapons, geography, search and destroy missions, recognizing the enemy from civilians and allies).
